



Dear Parents!

Welcome to the 2017/2018 school year. We are looking forward to an exciting year of programming and hope you and your children are as well. Each year, PiE supports the students, teachers and families of Delaware Township School through activities and events such as:

- After School Enrichment
- Elementary School Play
- Author-in-Residence program for all 3rd grade students
- DTS PiE School Directory
- ShopRite Gift Card program
- Direct programming through teacher grants, ie: Archery Club, Hershey “Music in the Parks” band/chorus competition, robotics club, girls STEM program, and classroom author visits
- In-school Assemblies, ie: OmegaMan, Renaissance Faire, Dr. Paul Wlchansky’s “Access to Success: A Dream, Motivation, and a Winning Attitude, and Dynamic Influence Anti-bullying and Social Media safety presentations (all 2016/2017 programs)

Small fundraisers throughout the school year and one large annual fundraiser have been used to support this programming in the past. This year we’ve decided to try a new fundraising model which includes annual corporate sponsorships and a per student program fee. Rather than ask for both your time and money for fundraisers throughout the year, we are requesting a one-time contribution.

The cost to run all programming organized by PiE each year is approximately \$75 per child. We are suggesting that families contribute at least \$50 per child for the 2017/2018 school year. PiE will track payments and participation fees for enrichment and the play will be waived for those who contribute the program fee. Additionally, if you need to split payments into Fall and Spring, please indicate below.

There will still be 3 student-driven DTS PiE events requiring additional monetary contribution, depending on personal level of interest – the Book Fair (October), the Holiday Shoppe (December) and the Mother’s Day Plant Sale (May). ShopRite gift cards will also still be available for purchase to any families who are interested.

We hope this model streamlines the year resulting in less volunteer hours needed from you as well as fewer communications. The success of this model really rests on participation and we appreciate your prompt return of payment and the form below. Low participation may result in less funding for teacher grants and diminished programming for students.
